

Anti-Bullying Week

Dear Parents and Carers,

During anti-bullying week we will be taking part in lots of activities to raise awareness and promote positive messages about anti-bullying. This year the theme is 'Power for Good'.

We have organised assemblies and workshops for all our pupils, led by Parent Zone. During these sessions the children will learn how to keep themselves safe on-line and how to develop their digital resilience. Our junior pupils will also discuss cyber-bullying and how they should treat other people on-line. This will include the inappropriate use of social media.

The children will also watch an anti-bullying drama called 'The Noise Keepers' led by Altru Drama. This will explore;

- The importance of speaking out if you are being bullied.
- Consequences of bullying.
- The reasons why people bully.
- Forms that bullying can take, including the use of technology.
- How to seek help if you are being bullied.

This will be followed by anti-bullying drama workshops.

We hope all the children enjoy taking part in these activities as they learn some very important anti-bullying messages.
