



St Anne (Stanley) Church of England Primary Sports Funding Outcomes and Evaluation 2014 – 2015

Outcomes

- Children's participation in inter and intra sporting opportunities increased significantly.
- Extra-curricular sporting opportunities increased significantly.
- Teaching staff supported through specialist P.E. teacher in delivery of all aspects of the P.E. curriculum.
- Children attended professional tennis tournaments increasing enjoyment and knowledge of rules and skills in tennis.

Due to a successful Lottery bid the school was able to:-

- Install permanent fixtures for tennis nets.
- Erect a new climbing wall.
- Erect a new basket-ball shooting station.
- Install new soft surfacing to back and rear yards.
- Arrange markings for a running track to be painted on surfaces in front yard and roof top area.

Last year St Anne (Stanley) gained the Bronze School Sports award in recognition of its achievements.
