Nursery reopens on Tuesday 5th January.

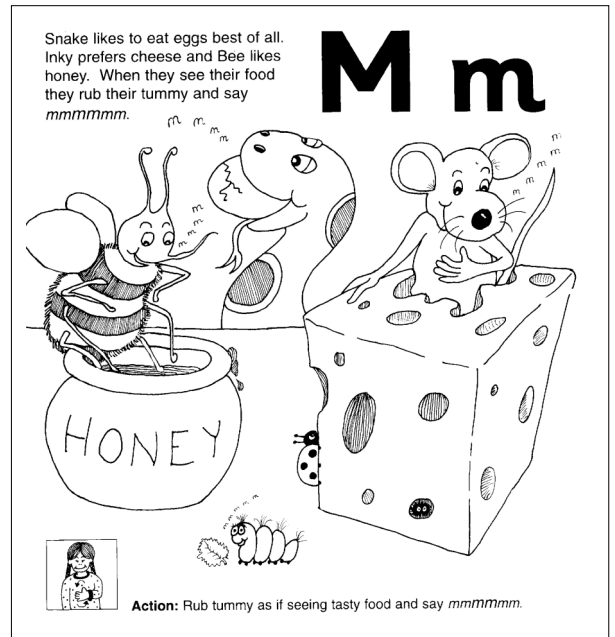
