With our Christmas Nativity play less than a week away, Children have been very busy preparing for their special performance on Wednesday ☺ We have been into the school hall every day this week to practice on the stage. Each child has been given an extra special part to play and they have all practiced finding their seats and special places on the 'big' stage. Their singing and dancing routines are coming along a treat and our nursery staff are so proud of how the children have progressed - we can't wait for you to see them next week.

Performances are due to take place in the school hall at 10.00am for our morning children and 2.00pm for our afternoon children on Wednesday 16th December. Children should arrive in nursery at the regular start time on the day (8.45am morning children and 12.15pm afternoon children). This will allow us time to change the children into their costumes and have a final practice. Parents must then come back to school for the performances through the main school entrance at the front of the building. Parents will not be allowed access through the nursery entrance as we do not want children becoming upset or unsettled before going on stage.

Our performance will last approximately 20 minutes to half an hour and parents will be invited back to nursery after the show to change their child back into their uniform. Parents are welcome to take their children home with them once changed.

We are hoping to do a dress rehearsal on the day before (Tuesday 15th December). Please try to ensure that your child is in school this day as we are hoping to film our performance - if your child is not in on this day they will not receive a copy of our special DVD.

Just a reminder that there is no afternoon nursery on Thursday 17th December. All children are instead invited to attend our morning session (8.45am-11.45am) for our nursery Christmas party. Children may wear their own clothes for this session. We have a fun filled session planned for this day with a visit from our friend Zimmo the clown along with party games and party food.



This will be our last session before Christmas as staff will be out visiting our new January starters on Thursday afternoon and Friday. Nursery reopens as usual on Tuesday 5th January.
