This week we have continued learning songs for the Nativity. The morning children will perform on **Thursday 14th December at 9.30am** and the afternoon children will perform on **Wednesday 13th December at 1.30pm**. If your child attends full days please attend the date most convenient for you. We hope you have heard some of the songs at home being sang, the children are doing really well picking up so many songs in such a short time.

In preparing for the Nativity we have started telling the Christmas story and have been given a set of “knitted” nativity characters from one of our school governors from St Anne’s Church. Whilst playing with them the children can retell the story themselves.

Many thanks to the parents who were able to attend the Phonics Workshop this morning. If you were unable to attend due to work or family commitments we will send home information given out at the meeting.

In maths we have continued to explore shape, talking about how many corners and edges different shapes have, whether the edges are curved or straight and if it will roll? We looked around the Nursery setting for shapes around us, maybe do this on your way home. What shapes can the children spot? How many circles can they find and so on.

The weather is getting colder and the children do have open access throughout the day to the outdoors so please bear in mind a warm, waterproof coat is vital as well as hat, scarf and gloves (though the nursery do have spare gloves etc if needed).
