Please continue to sign the reading diary. It is vital that your child has his/her reading book in school every day, as reading activities take place most days.</li> <li>• Year 5 have P.E every Monday. There are also opportunities for PE throughout the rest of the week. Please ensure that your child has a P.E kit (shorts, T-shirt and pumps), in school at all times. Kits will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed and returned after the school break.</li> </ul>
