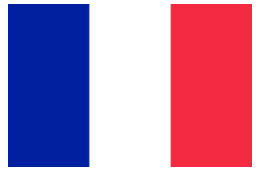

We have been super mathematicians this week, ordering numbers and finding the missing numbers in a number line as well as numbers that have two numbers that have been mixed up and put in the wrong place in a number line. (there is no fooling our Reception children!)



All the Reception teachers are so proud of how well the children are doing in phonics. They are enthusiastic to learn their daily phoneme (letter sound) and are trying really hard to put letter sounds together to read words (known as 'blending'). This is beginning to show in children's writing and weekly words.

Each Tuesday we have a French teacher come into class. The children are really enjoying the sessions learning French through games, singing and using actions.



This week we have been creating self portraits to be displayed in our classroom. Children have had to look closely at themselves in a mirror to make sure their portrait is a true representative of themselves. We have had lovely conversations with children when they have been describing themselves.
