Welcome back after half term. We have enjoyed sharing and hearing our half term news.

Thank you for your patients and support with the building work that is happening in our outdoor area. The children are taking it all in their stride and are enjoying using the other playgrounds.

This week we have been caption reading and writing using our phase 3 digraphs. Matching the correct caption to the picture then writing our own captions. We have also looked at sentence structure highlighting the different between a letter and a word. We have been writing sentences and counting how many words are in the sentences. We have also started our phonic assessments . It is lovely to see the progression children have made and this helps us to make sure children are working in the correct phonic group during phonics time.

A reminder next Thursday is World Book day, children can come to school dressed as their favourite story book character or wearing a story hat that they have made. If they are wearing a hat then school uniform is to be worn.
