Earlier in the week we took part in a 'book treasure hunt' in our school library. We will continue to visit our library and bring books back to class to enjoy.

Another exciting activity we took part in was to write our own class story to present to the author Jude Lennon. Earlier on in the week we had read 'Little Red Riding Hood'. We used this as our starting point and created our own Story called 'Little Boy in Blue and the Clever Fox'. The children came up with some really good ideas for the story, Jude Lennon was very impressed.

We have also been looking at words we would use to describe book characters. The children came across a few words they had not heard before, this led to us discussing what we thought they meant then finding out what they do mean.

In number we have been looking at halving. We spoke about when halving something it is shared into 2 groups. We used pieces of chocolate to investigate and recorded our findings. Children used the recordings to make a prediction of what they thought half of a certain number would be. Some children even noticed the link between doubling and halving!
