On Tuesday the children were talking about their favourite activities and areas they explored and played in whilst at Imagine That. This was our writing focus. We are reminding children about sentence structure, what phonemes and digraphs they can hear and encouraging them to use resources in the classroom to support their writing. Promoting their independence.

In Numeracy this week, we have continued looking at 3D shapes and investigating measure. We have used multi-link cubes to measure objects and compared their length using 'short, long, shortest and longest.' The children have picked this language up quickly and we can hear them using the words in the classroom provision.

In P.E, Miss Quinn has had the children practising activities for our sports morning. These have included the egg and spoon race, who can throw the rubber "rocket" the furthest and balancing the bean bag. We could see the determination and concentration in the children's faces and it was lovely to hear the children cheering on their team members.
