

NAS EarlyBird Plus - 4-9 years:

There are 8 classroom sessions plus 2 home visits. The children are not required to be present at the home visits. There are 2 places per family plus one professional. The family and professionals are encouraged to share information and planning, so as to provide the children with a consistent approach between home and school.

NAS EarlyBird Healthy Minds - 7-11

years: There are 6 classroom sessions. There are two places per family plus one professional. Healthy Minds aims to increase understanding of how autism impacts on a child's emotional wellbeing.

Autism Training Programme - 4 -19

years: There are 7 classroom sessions. The course aims to build on family's knowledge of ASD and help to develop practical strategies to support the children/young people.

Pre Diagnosis Course: This course offers families information and practical strategies to support their children/young people's Social Communication & Behaviour Difficulties whilst waiting for an assessment to be completed. It is a one day workshop.

Drop in Sessions: The drop in sessions take place twice a month in different Children's Centre's across the city. They are for family members or professionals wishing to talk in a private one to one setting. You do not require a diagnosis of ASD to attend but must have questions or concerns about the children/young people.
