Responses from students when asked what have you learnt?

"We can have two mums and dads" age 6

"Our families are like a love heart" age 6

"It is ok to be different and you can't tell people what to do as they can do what they decide" age 9

"Not to judge others if they are different" age 10

The main message of this workshop was...

"I want to love everyone" age 6

"To love everyone even if they are different" age 6

"Don't make fun of someone if they want to do something else" age 9

"Treat everyone the same and accept their beliefs"

If someone is being bullied for being different I would ...

"Try and make them feel better" age 6

"Tell off that person" age 6

"Tell a teacher and then see if they are ok... tell them that they (the bully) wouldn't like it if they done it to them" year 9

"Tell them that being different is a gift, not a punishment" age 10
