This may be in the form of worksheets, or it may require children to learn some mental facts.</li><li>• Please continue to help your child to read every night (no more than 12 pages), encouraging the use of expression and asking questions about what has been read. Please continue to sign the reading diary. <b>It is vital that your child has his/her reading book in school every day, as reading activities take place most days.</b></li></ul>
