This week the children have completed their first piece of writing. Some children wrote about their first day in Reception and others wrote about their summer holiday or weekend news.

All the Reception teachers are so proud of how well the children are doing in phonics. They are enthusiastic to learn their daily phoneme (letter sound) and are trying really hard to put letter sounds together to read words (known as 'blending'). This week we introduced the phonemes 'n', 'd' and 'm'.

We are already seeing and hearing super mathematicians in Reception. Super counting and singing number songs has taken place this week. Keep it up Reception!

We have starting talking about Harvest Festival, 'What harvest is and why Christians celebrate it'. The children have enjoyed learning about this and some were using their imagination in the Mud Kitchen "sorting fruit and vegetable for the harvest festival."
