This week in Phonics... Year 1

These are the Phase 2 sounds that we already know.

s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e, u, r, h, b, f, ff, l, ll, ss

We need to read and write the tricky words **the, to, no, go, I** and blend sounds to make words such as: **it, as, sit, pin, tin, get, if, nip, bin, met**

We have also learnt these Phase 3 sounds...Keep practising them!

j, v, w, x, y, z, zz, qu, ch, sh, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa, oo, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er

These are the tricky words we need to read and write: **he, we, she, me, be, was, my, you, they, all, are, her, said, so, have, like, some, come, there, little, have, one, do, out, what, when, should, could, would, want, oh, their, were, there.**

This week we have been learning the new phoneme 'i-e' pronounced as 'I or igh' and 'o-e' pronounced as oa
