

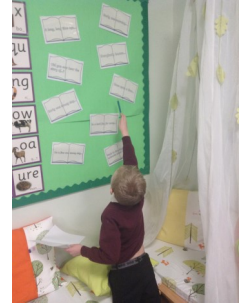
Reception Class Newsletter

Friday 13th March 2020

We have had some fabulous independent story writing and book making in Reception this week. It is lovely to hear and see the children so enthusiastic about stories and wanting to share their work. Children are becoming more confident when writing and not being afraid to 'have a go'. They are also using the resources in class independently, to support their writing, which is what we are always encouraging them to do.



In maths we have been using non standard units of measure such as our soft bricks, paper clips and multi-link cubes to measure different objects. Children have been using their number knowledge and mathematic language such as 'more' and 'fewer' to compare objects they have measured. We then moved on to using rulers to measure items. Children quickly understood that placing the object at the beginning of the ruler is the correct way to measure to get the most accurate measurement.

Mr Lucas has introduced a new topic this half term. Dynamics. He is very impressed with the children using the correct vocabulary and applying and building on new skills each week. Music is a lovely time to watch the children's confidence grow.
