Sticking with phonics and reading, another thank you to those parents/family members who could attend story time on Wednesday afternoon. The children enjoyed having you in our class, sharing stories with them. We look forward to seeing you again the same time next week.

It was lovely to hear the children's half term news. This was our writing focus this week and we are so proud of the progression in all of the children's writing. So many children are independently applying their phase 3 phonic knowledge in their writing.

In math's this week we recapped over 2D shapes and moved on to naming solid 3D shapes and their properties. We investigated and sorted the 3D shapes into shapes that will roll and shapes that will not roll. We applied our mathematical shape language and reasoning as to why some do roll and some do not (e.g. some have curved surfaces).

Thursday 5th March is World Book Day, children throughout the school are invited to come into school dressed as their favourite book character. If your child does not have a costume or alternatively does not want to wear a costume –they can come dressed in their own clothes with their favourite book.
