


Skills: Key Learning





Designs are for a purpose and usually come from a problem that needs a solution which has not been discovered yet. Your design needs to be purposeful and offer a solution to a problem.





Using a previous drawing, you can alter the scale to create a zoomed-in version of the original work.

Using the paintbrush in different ways effects the finish of the paint.




Artists sometimes draw from what they observe and see. However, some artists like to use their imagination to explore answers to unusual questions.

Artists often sketch their ideas down quickly, adding detail later in the process.



Using tone to create textures
Different types of pencils can impact
the thickness and quality of a line.



A HB pencil is harder than a 2B pencil.



Collage Drawing

After creating a collage, a collage drawing is when you use the collage created to sketch a copy of the creation, adding detail and appropriate colours.

Continuous Line

A continuous line means that you are not taking the pencil from the paper as you draw.
