



A zentangle is an abstract drawing created using repetitive patterns. The zentangle method is a form of artistic meditation.




Impressionism



Impressionist painters such as Claude Monet did not paint photographically and perfectly realistically. Instead, they show loose brush strokes and include movement in their work.

Impressionist painters did not paint religious paintings or portraits of famous people. They wanted to paint new types of subjects that hadn't been painted before, such as everyday scenes, landscapes and sunlight.

Hopper did several paintings depicting urban life. This painting, like most of his work, is based in realism.
