### Re: Coronavirus update - school closure to most pupils

# Following on from my last update, I'm now writing to let you know that we have now been instructed to close the school to almost all children after this Friday March 20<sup>th</sup>, until further notice.

As advised by the government, we will do all we can to stay open for the children of key workers (e.g. NHS staff, police, others in frontline services) and children with certain needs.

We are waiting for the government to publish more information on what this means, but it would help us in the meantime if you could let us know if you think your child may fall into one of these categories. Please contact the school through either my email address which is <u>j.simons@st-annesstanley.liverpool.sch.uk</u>, or through our school mobile number which is 07716711416. Please provide details of your child's name and class and your possible key worker reason. We'll be in touch again as soon as we are sure who this does apply to.

## All other children will need to stay at home, so we ask that you do not send your child into school from Monday onwards.

Please note that this is a national closure – as you may have heard in the news – so while it is a challenging situation, we are not alone. We'll re-open fully as soon as we can and will let you know when this is by text and social media (web site, twitter, parents face book page).

### What we'll continue doing while your child is at home

Your child's learning is of course important to us, so we'll continue to help your child to learn.

We have provided school packs and web sites for children to use until the Easter break. After this time, please see our school web site under class pages for further information.

Should you need to contact a member of staff, please use the school mobile number or email address as stated above.

If your child usually receives free school meals we will also be in touch with more information about how we will continue to provide this, with support from a scheme that the government has just announced.

### What we won't be able to go ahead with
