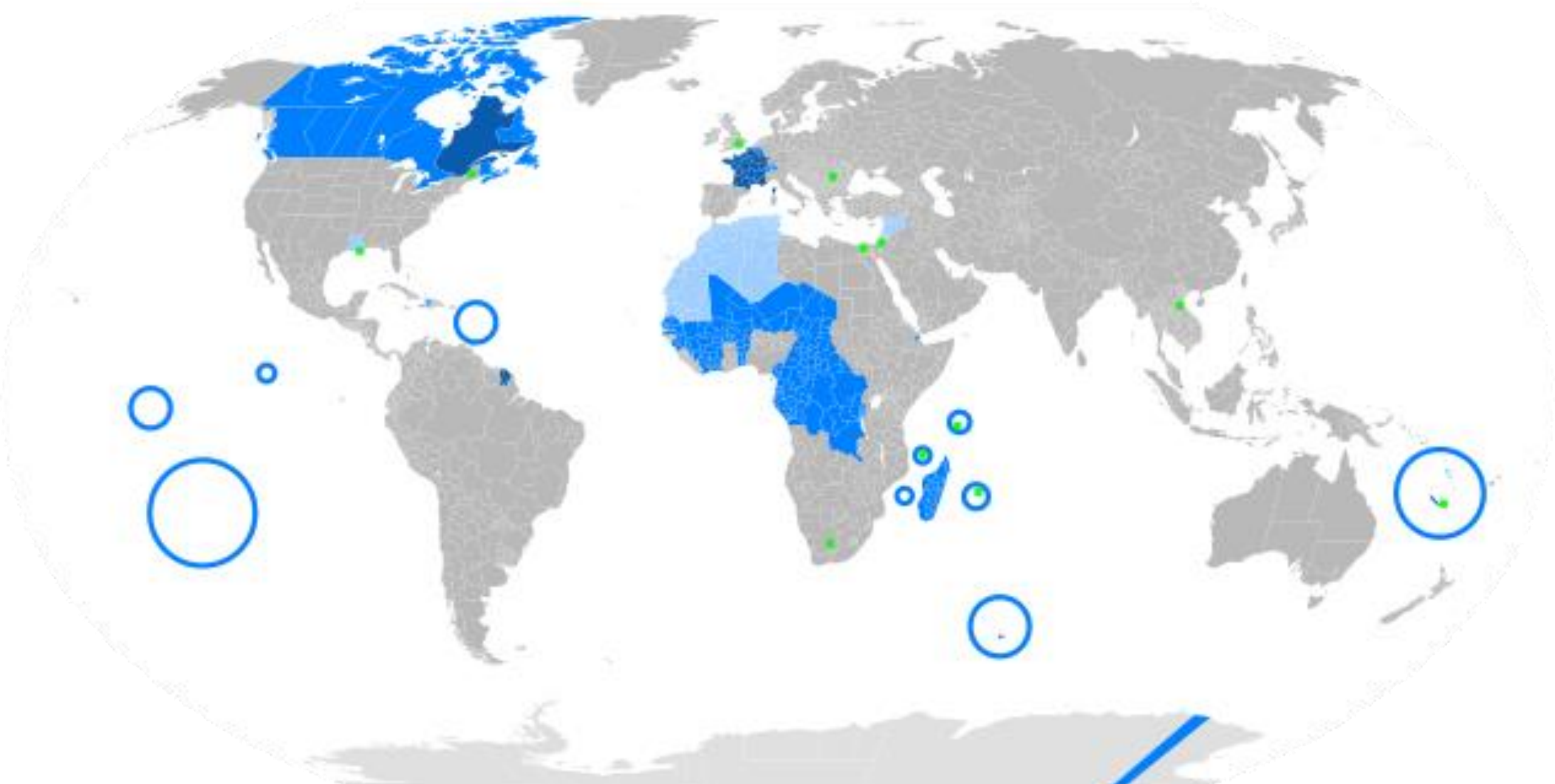

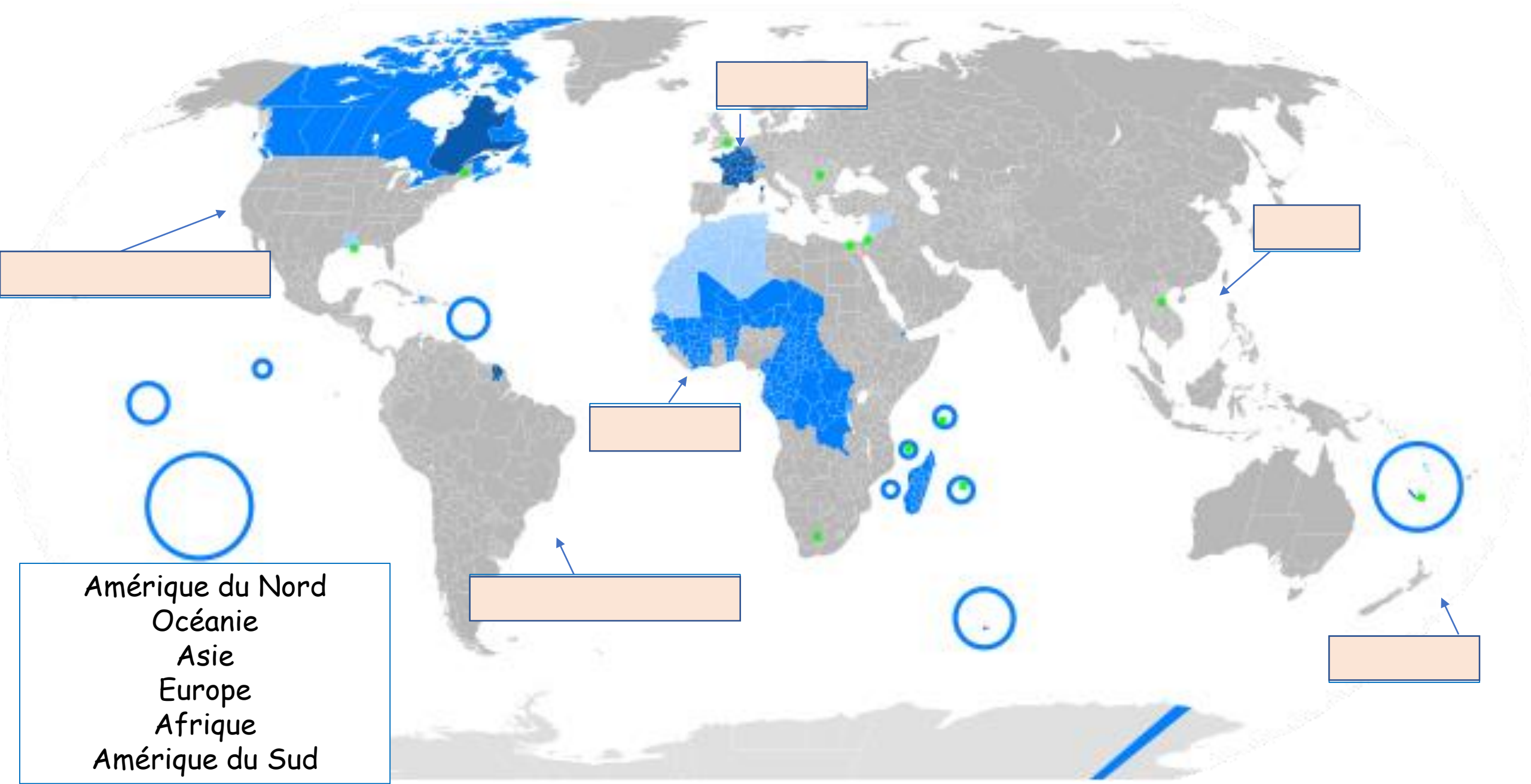

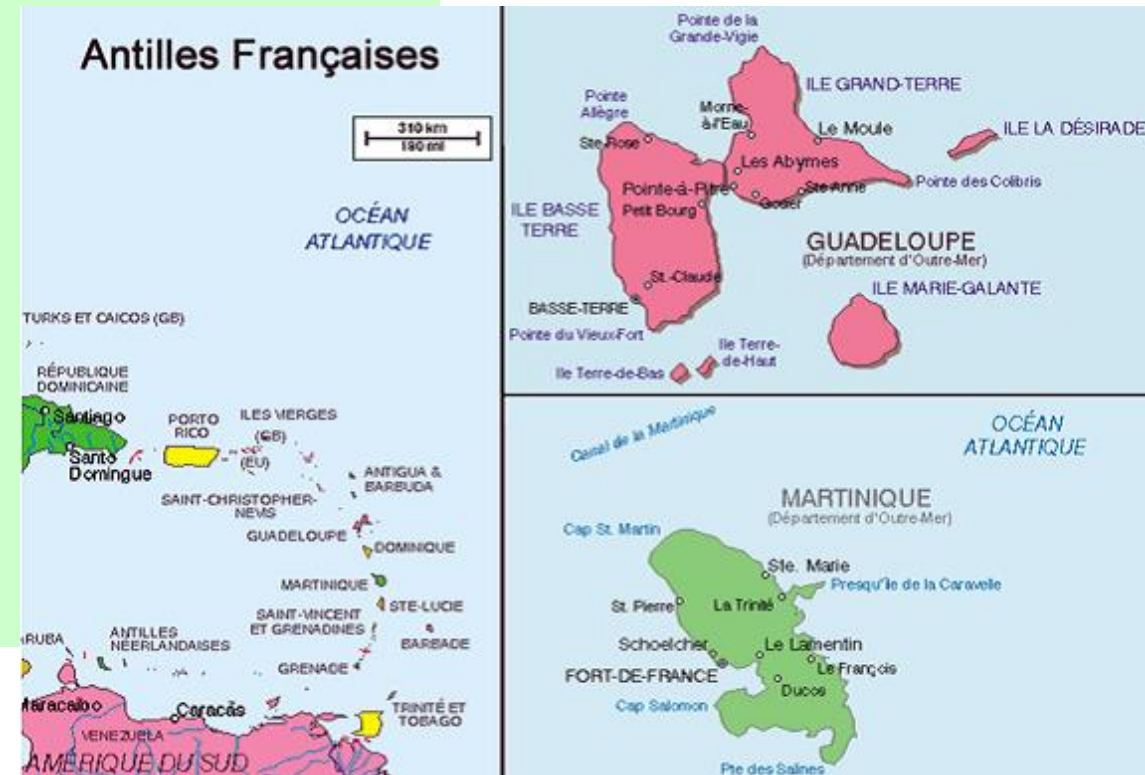

Les Antilles Françaises (the French Antilles) are a collection of EIGHT French-speaking islands in the Caribbean.

- Guadeloupe (including the islands of Basse-Terre, Grande-Terre, Les Saintes, Marie-Galante, and La Désirade)
- Martinique
- Saint Martin
- Saint Barthélemy
- French Guiana (although this is technically in South America)
