This week we have been having fun with words. We have learnt a new word, *alliteration*. Ask your child if they can explain to you what it means (When the beginning sound of words is repeated in close succession e.g. Sam's smelly socks. Charlie the cheeky chimp.).

We have been working extra hard in maths, doubling numbers and halving numbers. We had to sort out 'Sam's smelly socks' into the correct pairs. Then, count in 2's to check each sock was in a pair. We have 18 children in our class, this has supported our counting in 2's, counting when we have taken the register and at lining up time.
