

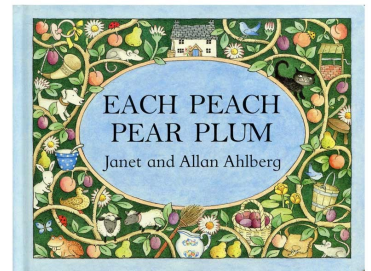
Reception Class Newsletter
