A big thank you for attending our 'Parent-Teacher Meeting' and completing the feedback forms. It was lovely to share with you all how well your child is doing and how very proud we are of them.

We are sure by now you will have heard (and been asked to join in with) our Nativity songs. Tickets will be sent home the beginning of next week. Please remember it is 2 tickets only per family. This is to continue to keep everyone safe, as you will be spaced out in the hall and masks need to be worn.

Our Literacy and R.E topics have joined well this week. We have continued learning about The First Christmas. We learnt actions to go with the Nativity Story, this has helped the children remember the story and be able to retell and sequence it. We recapped on what we learnt about Diwali celebrations and made connections about what we do to celebrate Christmas and how a lot of it is the same e.g. buying and giving presents, celebrating with family, having a special meal and attending a place of worship.

As well as building on our subitising skills we have been investigating the number four, using Numberblock Four. We investigated it's shape and use multi-link cubes to make different shape arrangements with four cubes. We began to notice sub-groups within the number four e.g. two cubes on top of another two cubes or as a line of three cubes with one on top, and a row of four cubes.



Staff have noticed children are bringing items into school from home e.g. bracelets, jewellery, toys etc. We ask can these be kept at home. We would not want them going missing and children getting upset.

If you are looking for something to do over the weekend, on Saturday 27th November, our school Church is holding their annual Christmas Fair. A special guest will be making an appearance in his Christmas Grotto.....Father Christmas!!
