He then went into each class and delivered workshops to further explain the work they do. Ian told a story of a boy called Omran, he was a 6 year old boy refugee who walked 1000 miles with a backpack full of his belongings. Ian asked the children to think about what they would pack. He reminded the children to think about the weight of their backpack and what items they would really need. This again was another very proud moment for Reception staff, children listened very carefully, giving sensible answers and suggestions.

Have you heard about Sonic and Sandy, the new additions to Receptions? These are our new Giant African Earth Snails. They will be based in Reception M classroom however all children will be involved in caring for them. This is a great learning opportunity for children and links in well with our curriculum— caring for living things. Sonic and Sandy will regularly appear on our school Twitter page.
