This week, we have had lots of fun constructing shape monsters. This enabled us to revisit and apply our knowledge of common 2D shapes.


We have begun a new maths topic exploring numbers to 5 . With a focus on numbers 4 and 5 , we have been representing, sorting and exploring composition. You can support your child's developing understanding of the composition of 4 and 5 through looking at all of the different ways we can make 4 and 5. You can play a game in which your child arranges a quantity of apples (4 or 5 apples) on a tree or on the ground. You can support your child to explore how many different arrangements of 4 and 5 you can make.


Don't forget to log into your child's Doodle Maths. You can download the app and log in using the login details we have sent home with your child. Please let us know if you need a copy of your child's login details. Your child has been set work on the app, work that reflects their developing understanding of number and shape. We are working with the children to access Doodle Maths in school. Please let us know if you have any difficulty accessing Doodle Maths at home.
