


Dear Parents and Guardians,

We have begun to explore numbers 9 and 10. We are learning to represent 9 and 10 in different ways. We are using 10 frames, fingers and beads to subitise groups of 9 and 10. We have been arranging 9 and 10 items into smaller groups to support the children to conceptually subitise these larger numbers and explore their composition e.g. I know it is 9 because I can see a 6 and a 3. You can support your child to develop their subitising skills through playing games such as 'Don't count, see the amount!' Enter the title below into an online search bar to join the Numberblocks in this educational

maths game all about the core numeracy skill of subitising.
