The children were welcomed back to a pirate-themed classroom this week. Following the children's interests, we have introduced a pirate theme to our role play area and small world area. Over the final half term, we will be having lots of fun covering the prime and specific areas of the EYFS curriculum through the topic of pirates. In relation to communication and language, we have been discussing what life would have been like for pirates on board a ship. After gathering all of the facts, we will be asking the children to vote for whether or not they would like to join a pirate crew, giving reasons for their answers.



Linking to personal, social and emotional development, the children engaged in a message in a bottle writing activity. We imagined that we were out at sea. As we listened to the sounds of the sea, we wrote messages, imagining who might find them as they washed ashore. With a focus on physical development, we have been working on our balancing skills through a 'walk the plank' game.
