The children had lots of fun getting involved with St Anne's Macmillan cake sale. We baked cakes to celebrate the work of Macmillan together with thanking our grown ups for supporting this great cause. We have continued to follow the children's interest in autumn through comparing autumnal fruits. We had lots of fun comparing green and red apples. We predicted and then tested which colour apple would roll faster and which colour apple would taste sweeter. We conducted an experiment using baking soda and vinegar to test which colour apple is more explosive.



We used our number skills to compare our predictions, looking at which colour apple gained the most votes in each experiment before testing to check if our predictions were correct. We introduced scientific vocabulary such as 'fair testing' through discussing how to ensure that our experiments were conducted fairly e.g., adding the same amount of baking soda and vinegar to the green and red apple under investigation.
