This half term has begun with a focus on shape. In keeping with White Rose Education (our curriculum framework for maths), we introduced triangles and circles. We began by identifying and naming circles and triangles. We moved to comparing these shapes before hunting for circles and triangles in the environment. You can support your child's learning by continuing our shape hunt at home. You could support your child to notice circles and triangles on the surface of everyday objects. You could ask questions such as 'How do you know that this shape is a triangle/circle?'
