3 Words of the Week

Shelter: A shelter is a place giving temporary protection from bad weather or danger.

When it started to rain, we stood under the shelter to keep dry.

Shiver: If you are shivering, you are shaking slightly because you are cold, frightened, or excited.

John shivered as he climbed out of the pool.

Similar: If two things are similar, they resemble each other without being identical.

Megan and Melisa had similar coats. Both coats were pink but Megan's coat had yellow flowers while Melisa's coat had yellow birds.
