Dear Parents and Carers,

It's been a busy week this week in Reception with the children making Christmas cards, decorations and calendars to bring home next week.

Can they sequence the key events in the story? This is quite a difficult skill, different to retelling the story as it is difficult for children to not include everything which happened. To make it easier maybe think of three key events in the middle of the story rather than just the one.
