Dear Parents and Guardians,

In Maths we are now focusing on numbers 4 and 5, how these numbers are represented and how we can show 4 and 5 in different ways. For example using our fingers, 0 and 4 makes 4 altogether, 1 and 3, 2 and 2, 3 and 1, 4 and 0. For the number 5, a similar pattern exists, 0 and 5, 1 and 4, 2 and 3, 3 and 2, 4 and 1, 5 and 0. For children it is important that they can recognise this pattern as this will help them to see numerical patterns as their maths knowledge develops throughout school. In recent training, staff looked at a Year 6 SATS paper. The mental maths section was reliant on children's quick recall. In Reception we are building this foundation.
