



Mathematics Home Learning

In Reception, we have been exploring maps, journeys and the wider world through stories, drawing, imaginative play and our classroom globe. The children have loved spinning the globe and “visiting” the place where their finger lands, helping them to understand that the world is full of different places, journeys and destinations. To support our learning, we would love to explore the wider world through the children's own experiences. Please could you note the name of a place your child has visited — this could be somewhere in another country, another part of the UK, or even another part of Liverpool.

We will use these places to talk about journeys, maps and the world around us, helping the children see that maps can show where we have been, where we are going, and the places that are special to us. We would love to show the children the wider world through their own lens and celebrate the places that are meaningful to them and their families.

The name of a place your child has visited in another country; another part of the UK; or another part of Liverpool:



White Rose Maths have created an app called **1-Minute Maths**. The app aims to help children build greater number confidence and fluency through targeted practice in engaging, one-minute chunks. Your child can choose any topic they want to try. They then answer a unique series of questions (a different set of questions is generated each time). If they're finding a question tricky, a 'hint' button will give a helpful clue by showing the question in a different way for example. When the one minute is up, you will see a feedback screen detailing your child's score. You can use this to move your child's learning forward.
