Dear Parents and Guardians,

If you have any objects or instructions at home which belong with the maths games can you please return to school. There are so many packs at the moment that we are unable to use due to missing parts.

We have managed to rebook Altru Drama's performance of Little Red Riding Hood for Tuesday 14th July. Morning performance will begin at 9:30am (Mrs Riley's Class) and the afternoon performance at 2:15pm (Mrs Bell's Class). Parents are welcome to join their children to watch.

In maths children are ordering numbers from smallest to highest using vocabulary, smaller than, greater than and so on. Some children are using numbers less than 10, for some numbers to 20 and others numbers up to 100 depending on their ability level. Revision includes correct number formation ensuring that numerals are written beginning and ending in the correct place. Please practise these at home if you can.

PIRA (Reading) assessments and (PUMA) Assessments are now complete and the information will be passed on to Year 1 staff. Miss Sargent (Phonics Lead) will also be completing the children's final phonic assessments in the next week or so. These will be used to group the children in Year 1 according to their current attainment and next steps identified to ensure progress continues from Day 1 in September.
